### Report 1: 100B Termination Statistics

Purpose: This report provides a list of cases that have been terminated during a specified date range based on Date of Termination on the 100B.

### **Users specify:**

- Cases terminated during a date range
- Start Date and End Date, Sending or Receiving, One or all Agencies
- List of Terminated Cases

Note: in order for a case to appear in the 100B Termination Report, a user must have created a 100B Closure (in which the 100B termination date is entered)

### Report 2: Children Over the Age of Majority

Purpose: This report provides list of Children who are over the age of majority based on whether the state is Sending or Receiving and the Child's Title IV-E Eligibility.

- Lists children whose age exceeds state's age of majority as of current date (system identifies)
- Report shows:
  - Child Name
  - Date of Birth
  - Case Status
  - Title IV-E Eligibility
- Staff specifies: Sending or Receiving

- Criterion based on the "Placement Made on Date" field entered by the user on case details

- Results include only active cases

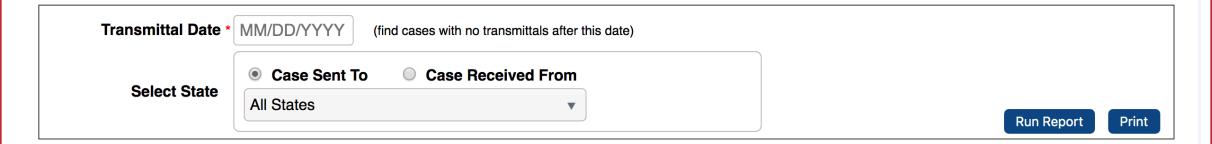

### Report 5: Home Studies Pending/Completed/Overdue

Purpose: Report lists Home Studies based on Pending, Completed, or Overdue during specified date range.

### **Staff specifies:**

- Sending or Receiving State;
- Pending, Completed, or Overdue, or All;
- Date Range, and
- Regulation Type.

Criteria for whether home study is overdue is based on each reg

### Criteria for Pending/Completed and Overdue

- Home Studies Pending All Home Studies open during the date range specified with the Home Study Decision status Pending.
- Home Study Decision Completed All Home Studies who have a Home Study Decision Sent On Date within the date range specified.
- Home Study Overdue All Home Studies that have no decision and have passed the due date based on the Regulation Type within the date range specified.





# Criteria for Home Studies Report-Overdue Based on Regulation Type

#### If not within these times, request is marked Overdue:

- Reg1: 5 business days for SS to send request to RS; 5 business days for RS to send response back to SS; Calculates based in the Completed Request Received date on both the sides.
- Reg2: Safe and timely processing for Home Study is 60 calendar days applies to the RS. This time starts from the Completed Request Received date entered by the RS.
- Reg4: The RS has 3 business days to complete the Home Study Request and send a Transmittal with a response. This time starts from the Completed Request Received date entered by the RS.
- Reg7: Local Agency CW must send the completed request to SS CO within 5 business days, date order is signed "Order Rendered Date" in the Court Details section of the Case Details screen.
   The SS CO has 2 business days to send the request to the RS Central Office. The RS must submit a recommendation within 20 business days of receiving the completed request.
- Reg12: SS has no time limit. RS ICPC Coordinator must provide approval or denial within 3 business days of receipt of the completed packet.

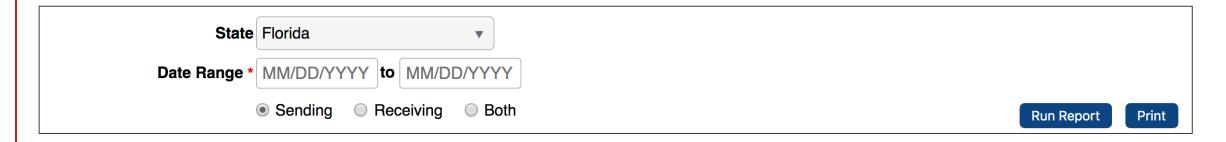

- 2. Home Studies request Out- The number of Regulation 1, 2 and 7 Home Studies sent during the month.
- 3. Placements In This is calculated based on the Placement Made On date entered by user on the case details screen during the month for your state as the receiving state. If the users did not enter the date, the placement will not be counted in the report.
- 4. Placements Out This is calculated based on the Placement Made On date entered by user on the case details screen during the month for your state as the sending state. If the users did not enter the date, the placement will not be accounted in the report.

- 5. Private Adoptions In The number of Regulation 12 Home Studies received in your state during the month.

States cannot place themselves in violation.

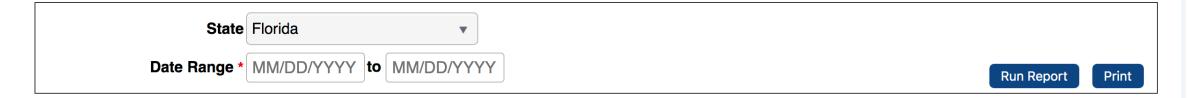

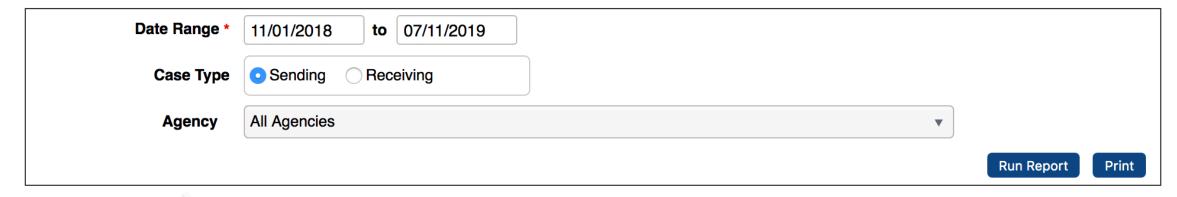

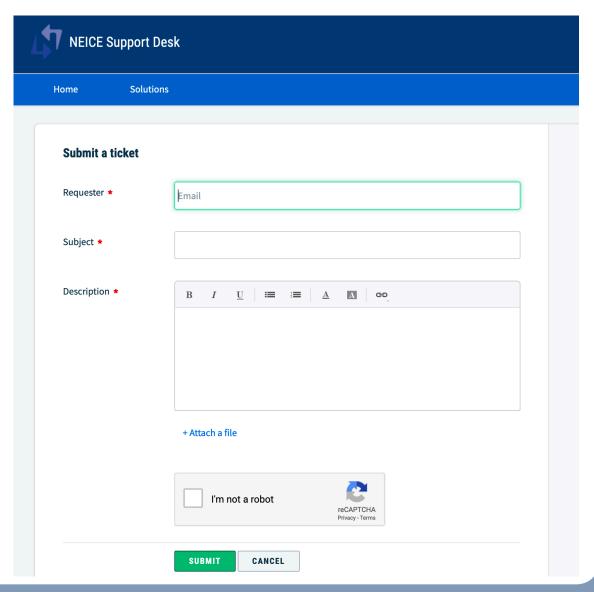
