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Overview

The purpose of this document is to provide the existing reports in the NEICE Case Management System as a reference for the states to create similar reports withing the state CCWIS systems. This document provides an overview of each report along with the business logic and requirements that are currently utilized to provide the reports in NEICE. These requirements may not be applicable for the data models defined within the state CCWIS systems but can be utilized for designing the functionality within the state system.

Report Name: 100B Termination Statistics

Purpose: This report displays the cases that are terminated.

Description: This report provides a list of cases that have been terminated during a specified date range based on Date of Termination on the 100B.

Conditions: In order for a case to appear in the 100B Termination Report, a user must have created a 100B Closure (in which the 100B termination date is entered)
