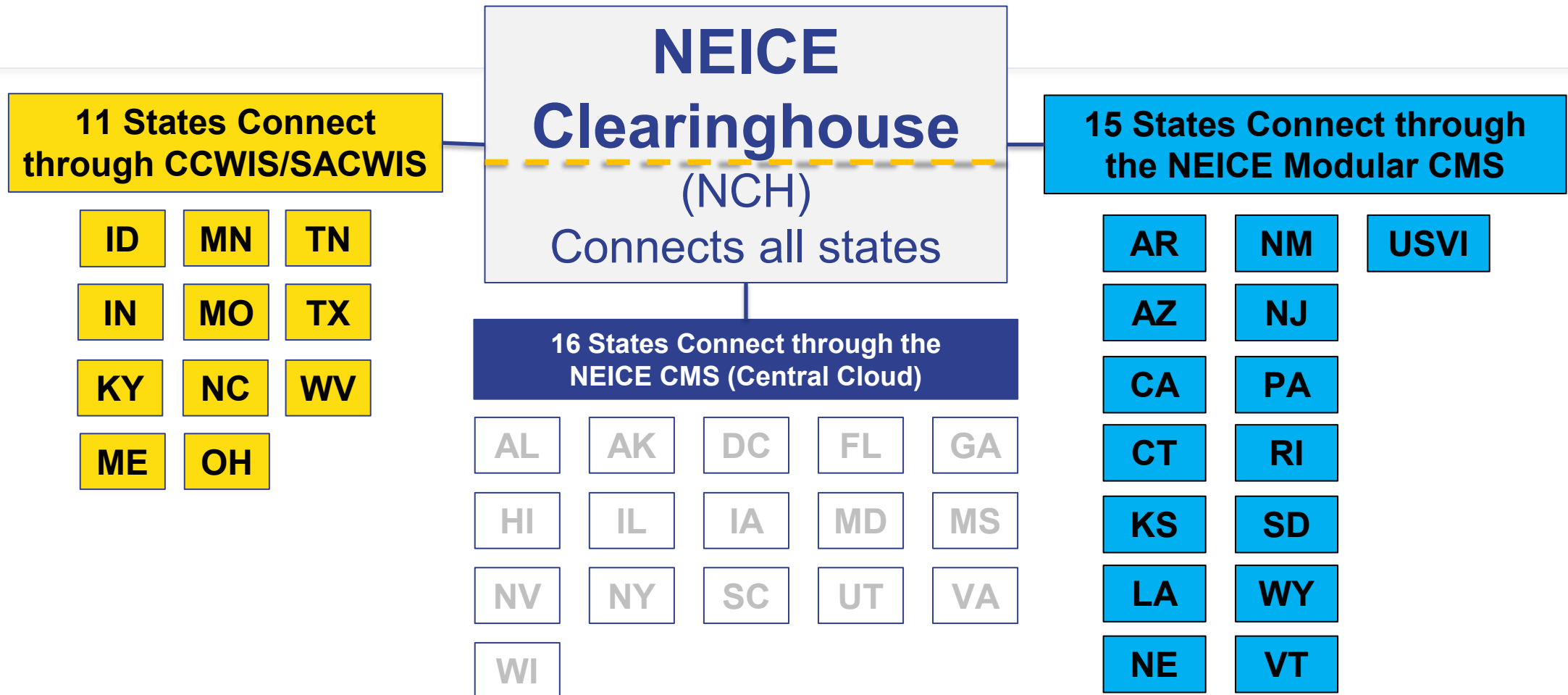


Setting the stage

1. NEICE Guidance Committee has been reviewing costs and fee structure for NEICE
2. During initial pilot in 2014, NEICE set the annual license fee at \$25,000 per state.
 - Fees have not increased since then, despite increased security, storage and number of states using system.
3. Annual budget is about \$2.5 m for NEICE, a national data case management system and exchange
 - Facing a budget shortfall in 2024
 - Note: Some states have used IV-E Admin, Promoting Safe and Stable Families and CCWIS cost sharing to cover license fees)
4. Guidance Committee and Executive Committee are
 - Exploring ways to reduce NEICE expenses
 - Considering adjusting fees to be more equitable for 2025 (possible options: charge by type of platform or size of state)

Guidance Committee and Executive Committee recommend flat increase per state for 2024 to cover shortfall.

Projected Budget 2024

Total Expenses	\$2,567,684
Total Revenue plus carryover	\$2,215,618
Projected shortfall 2024	\$352,066



NEICE Guidance Committee Recommendations

1. Continue to look at NEICE cost centers and explore areas for cost control and reductions.
2. Flat increase for all states of \$7,825 for 2024. (\$32,825)
